## **Common Practices of Preparation of Data Dictionary**

A data dictionary provides physical meaning of data, typically in a form of structured table. It provides definition and elaborates the usage and format of the data, as well as other information such as restrictions and relationship to other data.

When publishing datasets on DATA.GOV.HK, corresponding data dictionaries are required. The following three data dictionary attributes are the required bare minimum to include in each accompanied data dictionary:

- 1. **Name** A unique name of a data element.
- 2. **Definition** A detailed textual description of the respective data element.
- 3. **Remarks** Provide supplementary information.

For example:

- i. Default value
- ii. Acceptable values
- iii. Required
- iv. Data type
- v. Data format
- vi. Relationship to other data element
- vii. Distinction between other similar data element

It is recommended to provide the document in PDF format.
