Strategic Issues to be Discussed

Purpose

This paper invites Members to note the priority strategic issues to be discussed at future meetings of this Committee.

Background

2. At the first meeting of this Committee held on 5 December 2005, Members considered Paper Ref. CSD/EDC/3/2005 on “Strategic Issues that may be Discussed at Future Meetings”. In concluding the discussion, the Chairman said that the Secretariat would consider Members’ views carefully and prepare a list of priority issues that should be tackled by this Committee.

Priority Strategic Issues to be Discussed at Future Meetings

3. Having carefully considered Members’ views, we have drawn up the following strategic issues, in descending order of priority, for discussion at future meetings -

- (1) promoting the development of creative industries
- (2) Hong Kong as a hub for talent
- (3) high value-added logistics
- (4) creation of employment

4. In arriving at the above list, we have taken into consideration the tenure of this Committee and made reference to the agreed schedule of meetings (vide Paper Ref. CSD/EDC/4/2005 on “Schedule of Future Meetings”). We have not proposed a longer list as this Committee will have only eight to nine more formal meetings from now till the end of its term, and that it may take more than one meeting to discuss an issue and hopefully provide some broad direction on the way forward.
